Metting was called to order at 7:30pm by President Tom KB2NCI

The November minutes were summarized by Tom, no additions or corrections

The Treasurer was absent, so Tom stated the balance in the club checking account stands at \$2869.42.

RACES/ARES—Steve WB2VMR states that RACES will be called out on Monday, April 8, 2024, to assist the county as back up communications for the Total Eclipse that will go right over our area. We have 8 members that have stated that they will be able to help that day. More will be needed. Steve has a meeting with the officials on January 17 and will learn then what they will want us to cover. At this time, Steve believes we will be asked to cover the following: Hopewell EOC station, 911 center, FF Thompson Hospital, Clifton Springs Hospital, Geneva General Hospital. We may be also activating the Geneva City Hall EOC. It was mentioned by the county earlier that they may want us to cover select spots overlooking the Thruway to watch for traffic issues. More information to come. It is estimated that there will be an additional 350,000 to 500,000 people in the area for this event and that cell phone usage will overload the system and services may be compromised to some extent. Steve solicited for more hams to become RACES/ARES members. The next RACES admin meeting will be on Thursday January 18 at 9am and then Training on Saturday, February 10 at 9am.

ARES—Steve continues to work with the ARRL Western New York Section Manager to establish an Emergency Coordinator for Ontario County. We were all under the impression that we had had one for years, but that was not the case. Steve has had several conversations with the Atlantic Division Director to see about moving this along.

Steve WB2VMR talked about the New EMO Director, John Yannotti and that he started in early December to take over for Jeff Harloff, who retired in July. John is a ham (technician) and he is very interested in keeping RACES active. We look forward to working with him.

Repeaters—Steve states the Yaesu Fusion repeaters (VHF and UHF on Gannett Hill) have been installed. Due to an oversight, the Fusion function on the VHF machine was not turned on, but will be in the future. The Bridgecom Fusion VHF repeater will replace the GE analog repeater at the Geneva City Hall station this spring and the SIARC Yaesu Fusion VHF repeater will be placed in the VA tower this summer. At this time, we do not have internet connectivity at any site, so the full Fusion usage is not available. Maybe in the future. Steve is still working on setting up the linking of the 146.820 to the 442.200. The Fusion repeaters have internal controllers so the process is a little more complex. Ham Radio Breakfast---next on Saturday, February 17 at the Villager Restaurant at 8am. All are welcome.

Summer Field Day---June 22 and 23—after a discussion and information presented by Jay KC2TCM, those in attendance agreed to go to the Big M Gun Club in Clifton Springs this year. The facility offers a pavilion, kitchen, bathrooms, electricity, clubhouse and is generator and 24 hour operating friendly. Jay stated that the fee is \$200 per day with \$100 being refunded after the weekend and the area is cleaned up to their approval. The two clubs would split the costs. Since Drumlins has already agreed to go to Gannett Hill, Jay will work on swaying them to join us at the Big M. Tom KB2NCI has already secured the EOC property for Field Day as a back up and will cancel that later in the spring after we are assured that we will be going to the Big M Gun Club. Jay will let Big M know at their February meeting of our intent.
