

**SIARC MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING 04/13/16**

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:

- Presiding: President Tom Sanders KB2NCI
- Called to order at 6:36.
- Minutes of previous meeting read and approved
- Treasurer Stan WM3D reports balance of \$3,066.03 after deposit of \$110 for final clothing settlement; report approved.

COUNTY REPORT:

- Claim for lightning damage at Geneva station has been approved by county self-insurance plan; amount to be reimbursed to RACES account in EMD.
- Memorandum of Understanding with Geneva City for the station and repeater has been drafted; sent to Harloff for approval before going to city.
- Protocol for station in 911 Center drafted by Scott N2UMH; sent to Harloff for approval before going to Sheriff.
- Repeater lend-lease program form agreement in works.
- Surplus county repeaters: Steve WB2VMR reports gear is all at Gannett now, and one MSR2000 has gone to W2COP for the 145.11, another may go to Livingston. Three MSR5000 units and two or three MSR2000 repeaters, and about five base stations. Also 11 6.5 GHz microwave units, plus three duplexers, and a lot of misc. stuff.

TEACHERS INSTITUTE:

- Tom reports for Norm WB2GGM that teacher in Irondequoit may be accepted into program.
- Cost per teacher is around \$2000 just for housing and transportation; league is always looking for donations. Norm is looking into possibility that a local company might make space available locally to minimize transportation issues. Application deadline is May 1; classes run in mid-July.
