

SIARC MEETING NOTES FOR JULY 8 2015

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:

At 7:30 by President Tom Sanders KB2NCI with with 25 members or guests present. The previous months notes were read by club Secretary Ray Dreimiller AB2UY and accepted into record by the membership. The club Treasurer, Stan Avery WM3D then gave the treasurer's report with the account standing at \$3442.33. This amount reflected the addition of \$62 which was half of the \$126 raised from our table at the Drumlin's Ham Fest. The other half went to subsidize the purchase of this year's Field Day T-shirts.

GANETT REPEATER ANTENNA:

Steve Benton WB2VMR reports that he has the 145.45 antenna and flex line. John Park WA2SSJ has obtained three quotes for installation; these being \$3400, \$2000, and \$750. The third quote for \$750 is for the rental of a man lift whereby Public Works offered to install the antenna and flex line if Steve Benton is there to supervise. The \$750 will be taken out of the RACES budget. Steve will coordinate with Public Works as to when this can be done.

GENEVA REPEATER:

The Geneva 147.09 repeater is up and the link radio is repaired and will be installed soon. The Geneva EOC will need a antenna replacement soon. On a similar note we will be getting the new HF antenna tuner up on the Canandaigua EOC soon.
