

## **SIARC MEETING NOTES FOR NOVEMBER 11, 2009**

**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:** at 7:12 by President Scott Teresi N2UMH with 16 in attendance. This was an abbreviated business meeting with no presentations. At this time the certificate awards were handed out for the participants who took part in the activation of Squaw Island on Canandaigua Lake this Summer.

**SECRETARIES REPORT:** At 7:20, October's meeting minutes were read by Secretary Ray Dreimiller AB2UY; with motion to accept being carried.

**TREASURES REPORT:** At 7:30. Club Treasure, Stan Avery WM3D reports that there is \$997.19 in the club account. Stan went over some of the particulars of this years insurance policy in a letter dated October 28, 2009. Stan also collected the \$10.00 yearly dues from members present.

**HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT:** Nothing new to report this month.

**VEC TEAM:** Dave Foster AB2WZ reports that there was one new technician license issued.

**SUNDAY NET:** Tom Sanders KB2NCI net controller reports that there were 9 check ins with 5 from outside the county. The net was switched from 145.45 to 145.11 because of noise on the 145.45. During the net, Tom as controller went silent for 3 minutes as a test of our procedures. The net is going well however there is room and a need for more participants. 145.45 and 442.2 repeaters are owned by the County, while 146.82 is owned by SIARC.

**JOTA** Tom Sanders reported that there were between 6-8 operators at the Camp Cutler location. Norm Schrader WB2GGM operated in his pick up truck where IRLP contacts were made to Manchester England on the 146.55 repeater. HF contacts were conducted in the building. Several hundred scouts were in attendance and the activity went well.

**PUMPLIN PATROL:** All of the assigned bridges were covered with no incidents. The 146.745 repeater was used because of problems with the 146.82. Dave Foster AB2WZ ran the net control from the EOC. Some of the Police agencies visited several of the locations.

**REPEATER:** Steve Sykes KD2OM is still working on the interface and fixed it with the right geographic coordinates. We need to find the manuals for the controller so that we can link all of the repeaters we use.

**OFFICIAL DEPARTMENT:** John Parks WA2SSJ had nothing new to report. He is working on getting one of the County officials to give us a presentation on the new county communication system.

**NIMS:** Scott N2UMH emphasized the importance of the various NIMS courses have,

and how they will teach us how to handle emergency communications. Each course increases the level of emergency incidents an operator can handle. Scott recommends that we take any and all of these courses above and beyond that of which is required.

**ROTARY CLUB:** John Parks WA2SSJ reported that the Rotary would like a 20 minute or so demonstration on ham radio. A future e-mail will be sent out for those interested in this event.

**CHRISTMAS PARTY:** Ron Roach W2FUI reported that it will be held in the AWA ANEX. Turn in at the Peddlers Antiques off south side of 5&20 at the east end of the town of East Bloomfield. This year the event will be held in the AWA Media Center. There will be sheet pizza along with dishes to pass. Family members and, friends are welcome to attend. The event will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday, December 9<sup>th</sup> at 7PM. A map will be posted on the news center of the SIARC website. 146.82 will be the talk in frequency.
